

# **cPet Installation Instructions (ZIP version)**

## **1. Install Microsoft .NET Framework version 4.0 or later**

**cPet** requires the **Microsoft .NET Framework version 4.0 or later**. This is included in Windows 8, but for Windows 7 you should first verify that you have this installed on your computer by doing the following:

- Choose Control Panel from the Start menu
- Choose Programs
- Choose Programs and Features
- Verify that Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 (or later) appears in the list of programs currently installed on your computer

If you do not already have this installed on your computer, please download and install it from the following Web page:

Please note: you may find that you do not have the appropriate access to your machine to install this software. If this is the case, please contact your I.T. Support staff.

## **2. Choose location for program files**

For example you could create a new folder named **cPet** on your Desktop by doing the following:

- Minimize all windows
- Right click on your desktop
- Choose NEW
- Choose FOLDER
- Name folder cPet

## **3. Save the ZIP file to the cPet Folder on your desktop**

- Go to <http://dcarc.pae.osd.mil>
- Choose the cPet tab
- Choose the option to DOWNLOAD CPET
- Fill out the cPet Request form
- Double click on the cPet.zip
- Choose Save
- Select Desktop and locate the cPet folder

## **4. Unblock the ZIP file**

As a safety precaution, Windows automatically quarantines certain files that are downloaded to your computer. You may need to unblock the ZIP file prior to extraction in order to view the Help topics linked to from within cPet:

- Right-click on cPet.zip and select Properties

- Click the Unblock button on the General tab, if the button is present
- Click OK

#### **5. Extract program files from ZIP archive**

- Minimize all windows
- Double click the cPet folder
- Double click cPet.zip
- A list of files will be displayed. Highlight all file names and drag them to the cPet Folder on your Desktop.
- Encryption password is: OSDDCARC

#### **6. Create shortcut (optional)**

For easy access to the application, you can create shortcut and place it either in the **Start** menu or on the **Desktop**. To create a shortcut to cPet, right-click on the file **cPet.exe** and select **Create Shortcut** from the popup menu.

#### **7. Run application**

Double-click the file named **cPet.exe** in the **cPet** folder.
