# Obtaining UCC-G

To obtain UCC-G on the open internet please use the following instructions:

The UCC-G project is hosted by the Defense Intelligence Information Enterprise (DI2E). To access UCC-G, a DI2E account is required. Requesting a DI2E account is a 2 part process. (1) Proof of U.S. Citizenship, and in parallel (2) an online registration form is submitted.

Step 1 – Obtain a DI2E Account:

- Please request a DI2E account following the process outlined on the following link: <https://www.di2e.net/display/DI2E/Accounts>
  - If you do not have a CAC or the CAC/ECA instructions are not working, please follow the instructions for “JPAS Visit Request” or “IC/DoD PKI” (click the appropriate tab on the link above for detailed instructions)

Step 2 – Obtain the UCC-G Executable Program:

1. Once you have a DI2E Account, please go to the DI2E Jira (<https://jira.di2e.net/>) :
2. Create a new issue in the Project: Accounts (AC) of Issue type “Add Me to Group” and under Group Select: “U2C2-Read”.




Fig.1: U2C2-Read Access

3. Once your access has been granted (usually less than 1 business day), you can access the UCC-G Confluence home page where we have posted the current release executable and documentation.

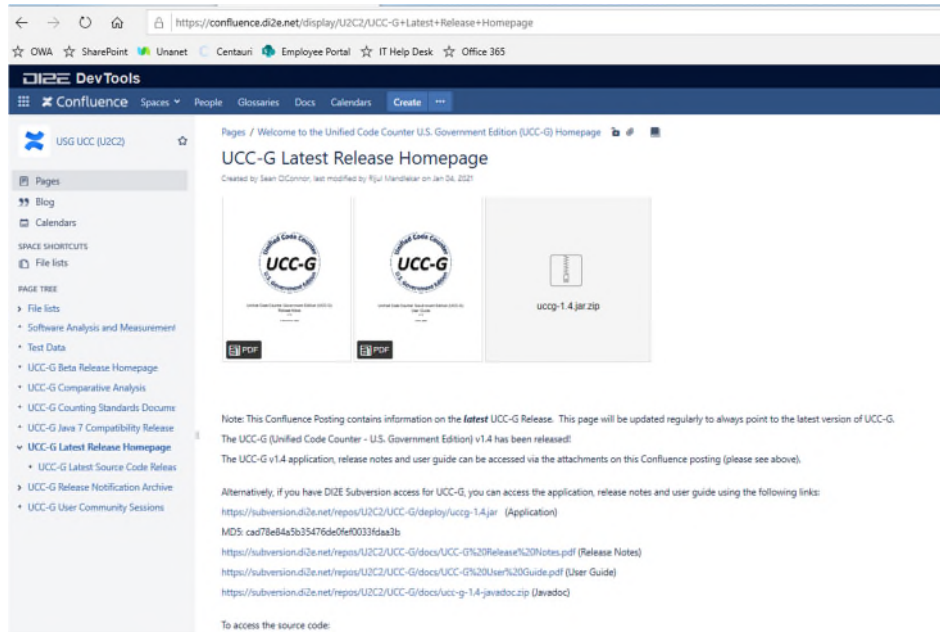


Fig 2. Downloading the release executable and documentation

### Step 3 – (Optional) Obtain the UCC-G Source Code:

- Once you have your DI2E account, please follow these instructions to request Read Access to the UCC-G project (U2C2 Read): <https://confluence.di2e.net/display/DI2E/Add+Me+to+Group>
  - see Fig. 1 above for graphical depiction
- Once your access is granted, you can access the repository via your web browser at <https://subversion.di2e.net/repos/U2C2/>
- Alternatively, you can use a Subversion client application such as TortoiseSVN to access the repository from <https://subversion.di2e.net/repos/U2C2/> - the current release is tagged Release-1.2.1: <https://subversion.di2e.net/repos/U2C2/Tags/Release-1.2.1/>
