

Unified Code Counter – Government (UCC-G) Tool Frequently Asked Questions

- Can an individual get access to the UCC-G tool and distribute it?
 - Within their program that has the SRDR CDRL?
 - Answer: **Yes.**
 - To subcontractors within their program that has the SRDR CDRL?
 - Answer: **Yes.**
 - Within a company or corporation to other programs/contracts with the SRDR CDRL?
 - Answer: **Yes.**
 - To the general public?
 - Answer: **No; personnel outside of the program/contract need to obtain the tool via an Acquisition Research Center (ARC) account.**

- Are programs expected to update versions of the UCC-G tool along the lifecycle or keep the same version?
 - Answer: **Use the same or similar version (no major updates) to keep changes minimal (e.g., SLOC +/- 1%).**

- Where can one send UCC-G product deficiencies/bug reports (e.g. freezing on autogen code)?
 - Answer: **Questions about UCC-G can be directed to acehelpdesk@westfields.net**

- Despite the government version of the tool being required per the SRDR DID (DI-MGMT 82035A), can any other versions be utilized if accessibility to the UCC-G proves to be too difficult/time consuming?
 - Answer: **Yes; if there are issues accessing the UCC-G required per the SRDR DID, then the University of Southern California's publicly available version of the UCC is an acceptable alternative for use.**
